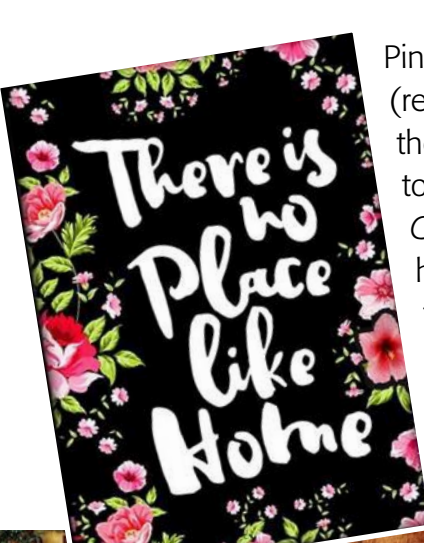
Going to Celebrate

Pincus Matz staff lunches are going to exciting places

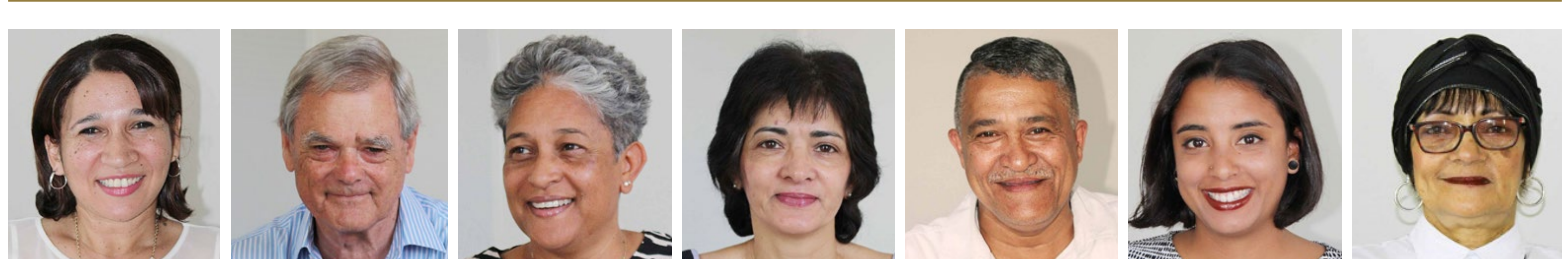
