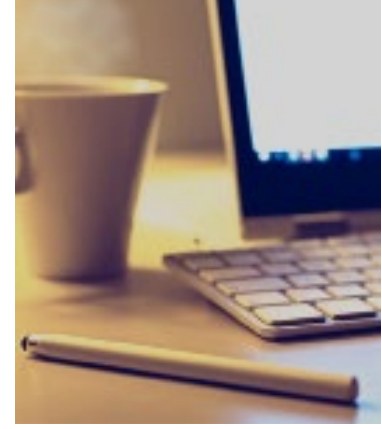


Many happy returns
