Irrespective of the season, be it sunshine or storms, at Pincus Matz, our culture is grounded in three core values:

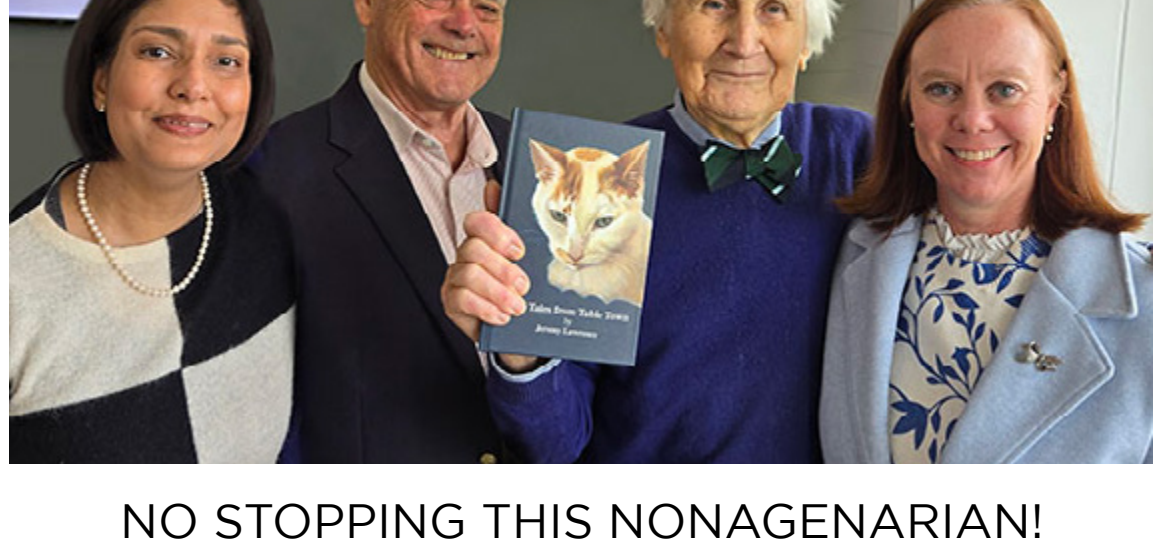
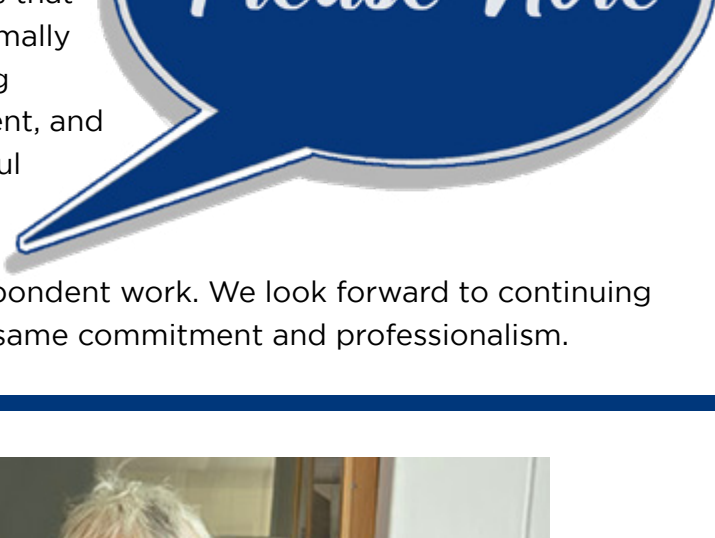
Acting with integrity | Building and nurturing relationships | Caring and being fair

WINTER WARMER PACKS

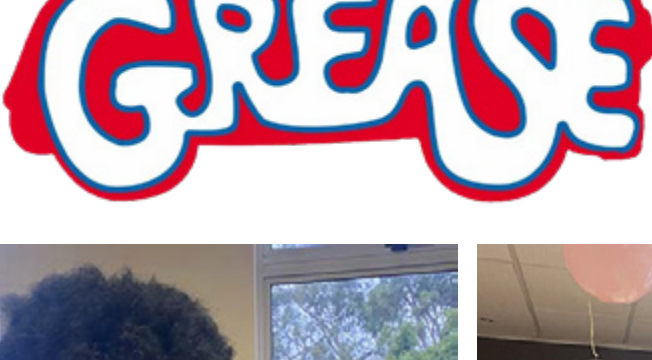
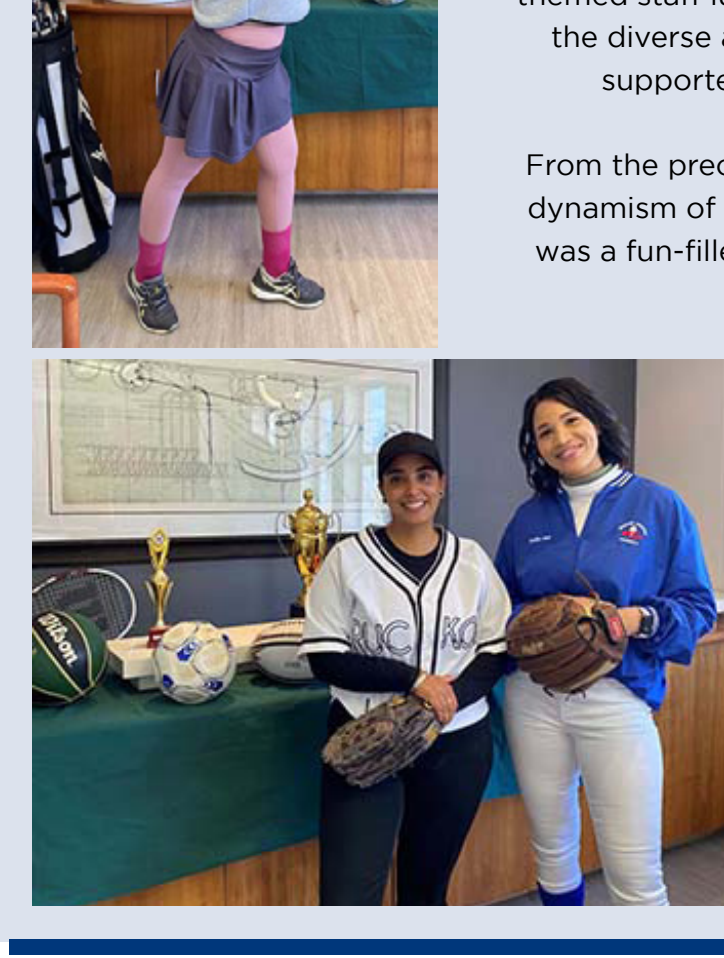

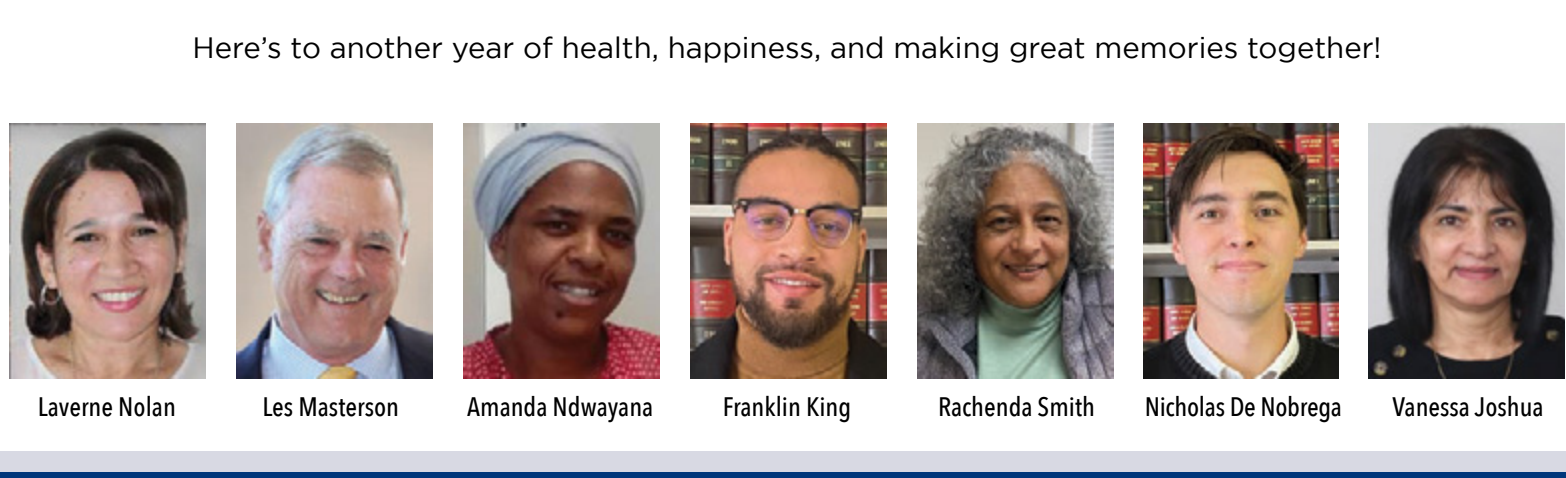
