Closing dates

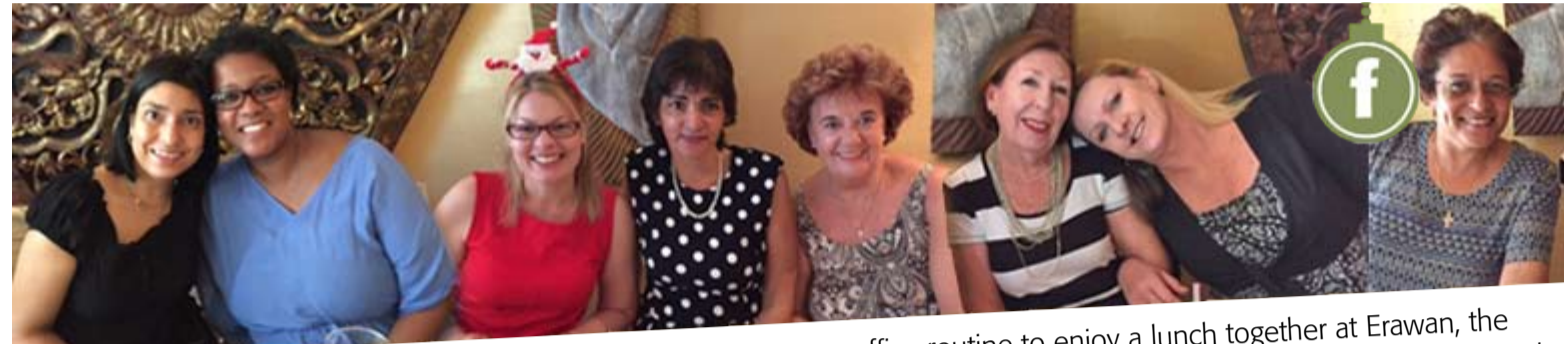
Pincus Matz will close at midday on 23 December 2016 and reopen on 9 January 2017.
